DSCC	One subject as Major course
M1,M2	Two subjects as Minor courses
IDC	One subject (different from major and minor)as Interdisciplinary courses (IDC)
AEC	One compulsory Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) on language(English)
SEC	One compulsory Skill Enhancement Course (SEC)
CVAC	Two compulsory Common Value Added Courses (CVAC) on Environmental Studies (ENVS) and Constitutional Values

Guidelines for Choice of Subject for 3 year B.A / B.Sc Multidisciplinary Course

- A student has to choose at the time of Admission:
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CC1 & CC2	Two subjects as Core Courses (CC1 &CC2)
M1	One subject as Minor course
IDC	One subject (different from major and minor)as Interdisciplinary courses (IDC)
AEC	One compulsory Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) on language (English)
SEC	One compulsory Skill Enhancement Course (SEC)
CVAC	Two compulsory Common Value Added Courses (CVAC) on Environmental Studies (ENVS) and Constitutional Values

Guidelines for Subject Choice for Three-Year **B.Com Degree Programme**

A student has to study in Semester 1 the following Compulsory Subjects

Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) 1 Paper	: Entrepreneurship Development
Value-Added Course (VAC) 2 Papers	: ENVS & Constitutional Values
