## Eligibility Criteria for Admission to SEMESTER WISE 3 YEAR B.A/B.Sc.(Multidisciplinary) DEGREE PROGRAMME under CCF,2022 (CURRICULAM AND CREDIT FRAMEWORK),

## 2023-24

1. (a) A candidate who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) or its equivalent Examination is eligible to seek admission to the $1^{\text {st }}$ year of the B.A./B.Sc./ (Single-Major) Course of Studies provided he/she has also passed in English having full marks not being less than 100 and fulfils the conditions as laid down in University of Calcutta Notification No. CSR/04/2023
However, no student shall be allowed to take admission after a lapse of more than $\mathbf{3}$ years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination.
1 (b) Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination or its equivalent from the All India Boards/ Councils (i.e. CBSE, ISC and National Institute of Open Schooling) need not require to submit the Migration Certificate) for getting Registration under University of Calcutta.

2 For the purpose of determining eligibility for admission to the B.A./B.Sc. (Muitidisciplinary) Courses, aggregate marks shall be calculated by adding the marks in top- four subjects in order of marks secured by a candidate. However, marks in compulsory Environmental Education/Studies shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks. However, if the subject "Environmental Science" is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.
2. (a) A candidate must obtain at least $30 \%$ marks in the subjects chosen for General cours
(b) Seat reservation for admission in the first year class of four-year (eight semester) degree courses of studies shall be guided by the West Bengal State Higher Educational Institution as Reservation in Admission), Act, 2013 and the West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Rules 2014 and Memorandum No. 339-Edn(CS)/OM-741/2023 dt. 26.05.2023.
(c) A candidate shall be allowed to take up the subject(s) under heading " $A$ " if he/she had passed the subject(s) under heading " $B$ " at the previous qualifying examination :
