

ADMISSION UNDER 4 YEAR UG COURSES (HONOURS/ HONOURS WITH RESEARCH)

Courses Offered (Major/Minor)

The Institution offers Major and Minor Courses under 4-Year UG Degree (Honours / Honours with research) in 11 (Eleven) subjects:

Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics, Geography, Economics, Bengali, English, Sanskrit History, Political Science and Philosophy

Admission qualifications:

A candidate may be admitted to the first semester of 4 year (8 semesters) UG courses of studies on passing Higher Secondary (10 + 2) Examination in general conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or an equivalent examination conducted by other State Board/ Council or the West Bengal Council of Rabindra Open Schooling or National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) recognised by the Distant Education Bureau (DBE), **Subject to fulfilment of the conditions mentioned below:**

In case of other Boards/ Councils a candidate shall have to pass in five recognised subjects, of which one shall be English, of full marks not being less than 100 each. A candidate passing in less than five subjects shall not be eligible for admission.

However, candidates passing Higher Secondary examination in vocational stream conducted by the West Bengal State Council of Technical & Vocational Education and Skill Development (WBSCTVE & SD) or any other equivalent Board/ Council are also eligible for admission provided that the candidate must have passed in five recognised subjects of which one shall be English.

Candidates shall be allowed for admission within 03 (three) consecutive academic sessions including the year of passing in previous qualifying examination. (For example candidates passing H.S. Examination in the year 2021 will get last chance of admission in the academic session 2023-24.)

Merit list will be prepared and published on the basis of Index.

Aggregate = marks obtained in top four subjects excluding the marks obtained in Compulsory Environmental Studies

CALCULATION OF INDEX:

Aggregate marks + Marks obtained in the Major subject/ Related Subject

OR

Aggregate marks (in Best 4 subjects) + Marks obtained in English

[for those who have not studied Major/ Related subject) in the last qualifying examination]

Student has to select one Major subject from first column, and one combination of Minor I and Minor II subjects from last column satisfying the special conditions as mentioned in third column.
