INFORMATION FOR ONLINE APPLICATION TO M. A. IN ENGLISH, SESSION 2026–2028

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Online submission of applications for admission will be accepted from **May 21 to May 31, 2026**.
2. Before filling up the Application Form, candidates must carefully go through the details in this Information Sheet.
3. a) The total intake capacity of the college for PG English is 40.
b) **80%** of the total intake capacity will be earmarked for the **2-year PG English Course** and **20%** of the total intake capacity will be earmarked for the **1-year PG English Course**.
c) **60%** seats out of 80% of the total intake capacity for the 2-year PG Course will be earmarked for **PART-A** category, which will be filled up by **Current Year (2026) Students of University of Calcutta, under CCF System** only.
d) **40%** seats out of 80% of the total intake capacity for the 2-year PG Course will be earmarked for the **PART-B** category, which will be filled up by **CU or NON-CU Students of Current Year (2026) and Previous Years up to 2022, under CBCS/1+1+1 years System**.
4. All candidates will have to appear for a mandatory **Entrance Test**, the date and time of which will be announced in due course on the college website.
5. Lists of candidates eligible for the Entrance Test will be published as per the schedule given in the table below under – **Important Dates for Admission to the 2-Year PG English Course**.
6. a) For **PART-A** candidates, the merit list will be prepared on the basis of **50% of marks obtained in the Entrance Test** plus **50% of marks secured in English Hons/Major at the Graduation level up to the 5th Semester** (1st to 5th Semester).
b) For **PART-B** candidates, the merit list will be prepared on the basis of Marks obtained in the **Entrance Test only**.
7. Reservation for Christian students and SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates is applicable for both PART-A and PART-B.
8. If the sanctioned number of suitable Christian and SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates is not available in the 60% reserved category (PART-A), the same may be filled by Christian and SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates in the 40% reserved category (PART-B) merit list and vice versa.
9. Any error or ambiguity in filled-up forms can be corrected or resolved with the approval of the appropriate authority (**Please write, if required, with 'PG English' in the subject row to admission@loretocollege.in**)

10. If any candidate cancels her admission within a month from the date of admission, a refund of tuition fees may be allowed, but the entire process will be at the discretion of the college authorities.
11. All rules are subject to change by order of the appropriate authority.
12. Application forms should be submitted **ONLINE ONLY**.
13. Incomplete forms and forms without relevant documents will be rejected.
14. Scanned marksheets and documents that are illegible or of poor quality will be rejected.
15. If an applicant is found to have suppressed any fact/information regarding previous degree, their application will be rejected.
16. The admission of a candidate will be cancelled, at any stage, if they are found to have suppressed any fact/information regarding previous degree, year of passing, or any information which may render them ineligible.
17. **Admission will be cancelled at any stage if a candidate is found to have not cleared all/any of the 6 (Six) Semesters' examinations or to have obtained less than 4.0 CGPA in 3-Years English Hons or English Major Subject (under CCF System) or to have submitted false/untrue information or insufficient documents.**
18. The detailed admission schedule (i.e., dates, time, venue etc.) will be notified from time to time on the admission portal of the college website.
19. All admissions to the PG English Course will be provisional subject to fulfillment of the eligibility criteria and other regulations.
20. Loreto College will not be held responsible for any error made by the candidate while filling up the form.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- CU or Non-CU UG Students having Honours/Major in English and having Passed/Appeared in the 5th Semester Examination and are pursuing 6th semester in 2026 (Under CCF System) are eligible to apply for admission, subject to fulfillment of other eligibility criteria.
- CU or Non-CU UG Students having English Honours and having Passed/Appeared in the 5th Semester Examination and are pursuing 6th semester in 2026 (Under CBCS System) are eligible to apply for admission, subject to fulfillment of other eligibility criteria.
- Students having passed English Honours (under 1+1+1 System) in or after 2022 are also eligible to apply for admission, subject to fulfillment of other eligibility criteria.
- CU or Non-CU Students having passed 3-years Honours not beyond 2022 (Current year i.e. 2026 plus 4 preceding years i.e. 2022) are also eligible to apply for admission, subject to fulfillment of other eligibility criteria.
- PG Degree holders are not eligible to apply.
- Candidates who were admitted to any PG Course previously are not eligible to apply.
- UG Degree holders in MDC (Multi Disciplinary Subjects) / General Graduates are not eligible to apply.
- CU or Non-CU candidates with a final mark sheet showing SNC (semester not cleared) are not eligible.
- Eligibility for admission to the PG English Course is subject to uploading/production of clear mark sheets of all years or all semesters within the stipulated time. (A clear mark sheet is one which does not show Fail/Arrear etc. in any subject of any year/any semester.)
- **APPLICATION FORMS WITHOUT RELEVANT DOCUMENTS WILL BE REJECTED.**

ADMISSION CRITERIA

I. Ordinarily students having Honours/Major in English and having obtained 4.0 CGPA in 3-years UG Degree Course up to 6 semesters (Under CCF System) are eligible for admission, subject to fulfillment of other eligibility criteria.

II. Students having passed all semesters, including the 5th Semester, will be considered for provisional admission for this year, subject to production of all cleared mark sheets up to 5th semester before the notified period. The provisional admission will be cancelled if the eligibility criteria given under **Clause 17 (General Information)** are not fulfilled.

III. UG Degree holders having less than 120 credits in Hons/Major English up to 6 Semesters or less than 50% of 120 credits from the English Major Core Courses as per NEP 2020 are not eligible to apply for admission to the PG English Course.

IV. Admission will be strictly according to the merit list.

V. A second Merit List for the candidates will be published if there are vacancies.
